

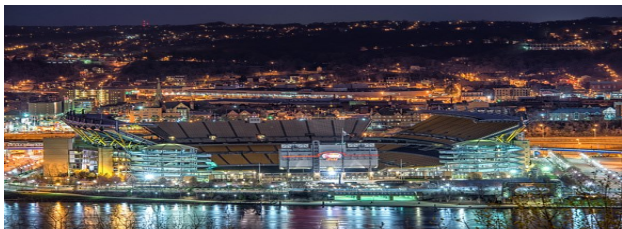
ABOUT PITTSBURGH

After claiming your luggage, proceed to the Super Shuttle ticket counter in the Ground Transportation/Rental Car area in the center of the Baggage Claim level to receive a boarding pass before proceeding outside to the curb boarding zone located by door # 4.

AIR TOUR PACKAGES

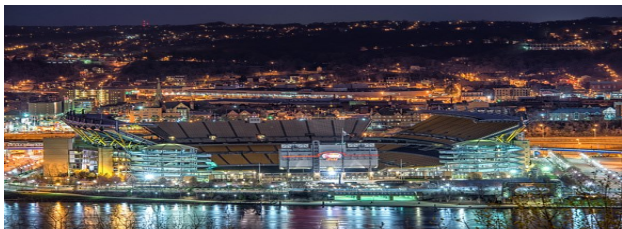
