AREA ATTRACTIONS

PIKE PLACE MARKET www.pikeplacemarket.org

Pike Place Market is the granddaddy of farmer's markets. It's a major tourist attraction with 225 craftspeople and more than 80 farmer booths—plus street performers and musicians. Bring your camera and catch a shot of the infamous fishmongers throwing the fish.

THE SPACE NEEDLE www.spaceneedle.com

The 41-second elevator ride takes you up 520 feet to the observation deck for a spectacular view of the area. Catch the monorail at 5th and Pine for a quick ride to Seattle Center's Space Needle, Experience Music Project and Pacific Science Center. Accessible via the Monorail from the Westlake Center for \$2.50 pp each way.

SEATTLE WATERFRONT <https://waterfrontseattle.org>

With spectacular views of Elliott Bay, Seattle's waterfront is a bustling collection of attractions, restaurants and shopping. It also is starting points for ferries, cruise ships, the Victoria Clipper and Argosy boat tours.

Meet Sekiu, the sea otter pup born at the Aquarium. Walk under the water in a glass dome with a 360 degree view into a 400,000 gallon tank filled with hundreds of fascinating Puget Sound fish.
